

The Morrison formation

It represents one of the world's most important sites. It is the origin of thousands of late Jurassic fossil remains, some belonging to most popular dinosaurs. It is located in the United States and contains rocks that were deposited under an arid climate with seasonal rains.



DISCOVERERS
Since the end of the 1800s, the Morrison formation has been the most famous source of paleontological finds. Charles and Othniel Marsh were the first to make significant contributions to the geological study of fossils.



FOSSILS
The Morrison Formation is a fossil-rich site. Paleontologists have identified thousands of fossil remains, including numerous species of mammals and invertebrates, as well as the fossilization of several species.



ENVIRONMENT

Seasonal rains and abundant vegetation contributed to the development of great savannas that became the biggest ever.

A TITANIC REPTILE

A paleontological site with a large number of other remains discovered only 1,000 meters away, as they were buried 150 million years ago in a river bed.



FAUNA

The Morrison Formation is a prehistoric site, featuring the plants and animal species preserved as important fossil collections.
