

Diagnosis and treatment of oral medicine conditions

Oral medicine is a specialty combining dental and medical knowledge to treat patients with non-dental complaints of the mouth and face. This article aims to provide a brief insight into the diagnosis and treatment of oral medicine conditions that may be seen in the dental practice

Oral medicine is the dental specialty concerned with the diagnosis and non-surgical management of patients with chronic, recurrent or medically related disorders of the oral and maxillofacial region (British Society for Oral Medicine, 2011).

The scope of conditions seen within oral medicine is broad and while some are limited to just the mouth and face, many will be the oral manifestations of much more widespread disease. Therefore, diagnosis and treatment of patients within oral medicine often involves liaison and crossover with medical specialties: gastroenterology for conditions such as Crohn's disease; rheumatology for the management of Sjögren's syndrome and other autoimmune complaints; neurology for the care of chronic facial pains such as trigeminal neuralgia; and dermatology in the cases of lichen planus and blistering diseases.

Ulceration

Recurrent aphthous stomatitis

Oral ulceration can be caused by trauma,

infection, malignancy or immunological problems. While the majority of individuals will have a mouth ulcer from time to time, there are patients who suffer from large numbers of ulcers and may rarely be ulcer-free. This condition is called 'recurrent aphthous stomatitis' (RAS), and affects up to 25% of people (Ship et al, 2000). Although the cause of RAS is unknown, it is suspected that blood deficiencies, such as anaemia, sensitivity to chemicals in foods such as benzoates, hormonal upset and stress can all lead to worsening of ulceration in susceptible patients.

The first step in the treatment of RAS is the elimination of exacerbating factors, such as the correction of blood deficiencies or elimination of suspected foods from the diet. If ulceration persists then a wide range of treatments for RAS is available. Products containing benzoylamine are analgesic, while chlorhexidine mouthwashes and gels may reduce the duration of ulceration and increase the number of ulcer-free days (Addy et al, 1976; Hunter and Addy, 1987). However, corticosteroids such as prednisolone make up the mainstay of RAS treatment. These are applied topically through dissolvable pellets, mouthwashes and sprays and while they don't stop ulcers, they appear to reduce symptoms and increase healing (Scully et al, 2008).

Herpes infections

The herpes simplex type 1 virus (HSV-1) is most commonly encountered in the dental surgery in the form of cold sores.

Most patients first encountered the virus as a child and may have suffered to a greater or lesser degree with 'primary herpetic gingivostomatitis', a self-limiting flu-like infection with painful gingivitis, blood crusting of the lips and an associated fever (Figure 1).

After the initial infection resolves the virus can lie dormant in the nerve tissue of the lips until it is reactivated during periods of illness or stress, or in response to sunlight or trauma. This reactivation is often accompanied by a tingling 'prodrome' in the lips, during which time oral or topical antivirals such as acyclovir may be beneficial. It is important to remember that patients may shed the virus through their saliva even when they don't have a cold sore, so excellent standards of infection control are important at all times (Miller and Danher, 2008).

White patches

White patches within the mouth can arise due to a large number of causes. While they are most commonly caused by trauma (keratosis), a high level of suspicion is maintained for any non-resolving white patch, as it may be oral cancer.

Lichen planus

Lichen planus is a mucocutaneous disorder that can occur on the skin or in the mouth. It is found in around 2% of the population and arises when white blood cells recognize the epithelial cells of the skin or mucosa as 'foreign' due to changes
