
Week 1

Beat can be felt with or without sound. We clap, walk, tap, march, dance, and play musical instruments to show the rhythm and beat of music.

- The symbol (I) shows the pulse of the sound.
- Rest (♩) is the symbol used to show silence.
- We can feel the pulse through clapping, tapping, walking, chanting, and playing rhythmic instruments.
