Le département des Antiquités orientales du musée du Louvre accueille à titre exceptionnel des œuvres majeures du Metropolitan Museum of Art (The Met) de New York. Ce temps de la fermeture pour rénovation globale des salles du département d'Art du Proche-Orient amène, au sein des collections permanentes, de lourdes œuvres égyptiennes venues de The Met, en dialogue inédit avec les collections louviennes. Datées entre la fin du IV^e millénaire avant J.-C. et le III^e siècle de notre ère, les œuvres venues exceptionnellement du New York introduisent de remarquables correspondances avec celles du Louvre, apportant l'ensemble une palette riche pour la première fois à cette occasion des deux collections se complétant du fait des spécificités liées à l'histoire respective des deux collections. De l'Asie centrale à la Syrie en passant par l'Égypte et la Mésopotamie, ces dialogues émerveillés orientales permettent de redécouvrir autrement ces vestiges plurimillénaires et les histoires dont ils témoignent.

The Musée du Louvre's Department of Near Eastern Antiquities is exceptionally featuring some major works from New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art (The Met), during the closure for renovation of the Department of Ancient Near Eastern Art. In its permanent galleries, the Louvre has exhibited with The Met an unique dialogue between these two collections. During three millennia (the end of the fourth millennium B.C. and the fifth century A.D.), The Met's works, in exceptional grants, introduce remarkable correspondences with the Louvre's collections, either because they form a pair destined for the first time on this occasion, or because they complement each other due to the specificities linked to the respective histories of the two collections. From Central Asia to Syria, often passing through Iran and Mesopotamia, these dialogues between Near Eastern antiquities will allow to redécouvrir in a different way these remarkable multi-millennial artefacts and the histories to which they bear witness.
