Scholars from Germany, Switzerland and Namibia engaged in intense discussions on a wide range of texts, genres and research methodologies for two days. This book contains some of the papers presented at the 2019 symposium as well as further presentations on narrating Africa. Like the open space project this publication does not presume to give an answer to the difficult question of how to narrate Africa but rather it seeks to offer further insights into the field with a special focus on Namibian narrations. This book is divided into four different sections. The first part aims to provide an introductory overview to and reflections of the project's main theme narrating Africa. In part two identity is explored and re-considered along various literary texts and with a particular focus on questions of gender. The third part focuses on oral literature and questions of time and memory. Finally the last chapters are dedicated to the archive and colonialism exploring a variety of archive materials in Marbach and in Windhoek and how they take up and shape facts and fantasies of Namibia and Africa.
