If each project site is expected to take part in or support the overall program evaluation, then these individuals frequently serve as links between their projects and the larger cross-project evaluation of the funded program. The field has not until now addressed the topic of how being asked or required to participate in such evaluations affects these people who play a critical role in multisite evaluations. This issue does so in two ways. The first six chapters present data and related analyses from research on four multisite evaluations documenting the patterns of involvement in these evaluation projects and the extent to which different levels of involvement in program evaluations resulted in different patterns of evaluation use and influence. The remaining chapters offer reflections on the results of the cases or their implications, some by people who were part of the original research and some by those who were not. The goal is to encourage readers to think actively about ways to improve multisite evaluation practice.
