Septuagint: Jeremiah Scriptural Research Institute,1901 The Book of

Jeremiah was likely added to the Septuagint sometime before 165 BC as it does not appear to have been influenced by the Hasmonean redaction found in the Masoretic Texts and the Dead Sea Scrolls The Book of Jeremiah is one of the least standardized texts of the Septuagint with more than one Greek translation surviving and not all copies of the Septuagint using the same version The Masoretic and Peshitta versions are also different resulting in multiple versions of the Book of Jeremiah These versions all include essentially the same text however organized into different chapter structures These variant readings appear to date back to the Aramaic source texts that the Greek and Hebrew translations are based on It is unclear if the Syriac version of Jeremiah in the Peshitta was a copy of an Aramaic Jeremiah or translated from one of the Greek versions however is similar to a Greek version meaning either it was translated from the Greek version or was the source for the Greek version There were attempts to standardize the Septuagint and Syriac precursors to the Peshitta and so it is unclear which version influenced which This question of which order the chapters of Jeremiah should be in is similar to the question of which order the books of the prophets should be in In the Septuagint Jeremiah follows Isaiah and precedes Ezekiel which is the same order as in the Masoretic Texts however in the Peshitta Jeremiah is the first of these three books In the Masoretic Texts the Twelve Prophets follow the three Latter Prophets however in both the Septuagint and Peshitta the Twelve precede the Three It is not in question that the twelve were translated as the Dodeka before being added to the Septuagint however the question of when Isaiah Jeremiah Ezekiel and Baruch were translated remains a question Isaiah appears to have been partially redacted by Simon the Zealot before being translated into Greek and therefore the translation likely took place sometime between 145 and 140 BC However Jeremiah does not show signs of Simon s edits and so likely predates the Maccabean Revolt According to rabbinical tradition Jeremiah came before Isaiah in the scriptures before the Hasmonean era which supports the Peshitta s book structure and explains why the Greeks would have translated it before Isaiah The first 24 chapters of the various books of Jeremiah all follow the same order implying that these were the original Book of Jeremiah Likewise the final chapter chapter 52 is always the same chapter implying it was added on later Chapter 52 appears to have been extracted from another book about the history of Judah and may have originated in the lost Chronicles of the Kings of Judah which was mentioned in 3rd Kingdoms Masoretic Kings Chapters 25 through 51 follow different orders however all appear to have been based on Aramaic source texts The Hebrew translation maintains many Aramaic words mixed into the Hebrew while the Greek has transliterated Aramaic words which had to have originated in an Aramaic source It is unclear which so many chapter structures exist or if they were present in the Aramaic texts however other differences between the Greek and Hebrew texts are clearly inherited from the Aramaic implying the divergent chapter structures originated in the Aramaic texts as well

Septuagint: Ezekiel Scriptural Research Institute,Ezekiel ben Buzi,1901 The

Book of Ezekiel is certainly one of the strangest books to survive from antiquity and has been the source of much speculation throughout centuries by Jews Christians and atheists alike Ezekiel s opening vision of the flying machine was the source of an entire branch of Jewish literature Merkabah mysticism Merkabah which translates as chariot developed during the Second Temple era and had a major impact on early Christian literature although was ultimately abandoned by both Jews and Christians The Christians abandoned the cloud literature during the creation of orthodoxy and the Talmud includes many interdictions concerning Merkabah speculation Merkabah and the Heikhalot literature that developed from it ultimately fell out of favor in the 11th century AD The Book of Ezekiel recounts a series of visions that Ezekiel had over the course of his life in the late 600s and early 500s BC Most of Ezekiel s prophecies were set during the rise of the Neo Babylonian Empire and his view of who the Israelites were is fundamentally different than the view generally expressed According to Ezekiel the Israelites were Canaanites the descendants of Amorites and Minoans or Hittites in an alternate interpretation This is clearly not the view that was popular in Judah either when it was independent or later under Babylonian or Persian rule Several contradictions exist between the writings of Ezekiel and the Torah which suggests that the Torah was not fully composed at the time or if it was composed not in circulation where Ezekiel lived It is also a fact that Ezekiel did not mention Moses or Aaron yet did refer to the Israelites leaving Egypt which Moses and Aaron were central to He mentioned Job and Noah as well as the ancient Canaanite hero Danel and Abraham but under his older name Abram suggesting that he had not read Genesis in which Abram s name was changed to Abraham The description of Ezekiel s thunder god or his flying chariot or his flying wheels depending on the interpreter is by far the strangest part of the book It contains many references to electricity which were generally omitted from early translations due to the belief that electricity was magical nonsense The rediscovery of electricity in the early modern era was largely based on the Classical Greek records of their experiments with amber which is where William Gilbert derived the English term electricity from lectrou meaning amber The earliest surviving record of experimentation with electrostatic fields was by Thales of Miletus who lived between approximately 624 and 548 BC which is the same time as the life of Ezekiel circa 630 to 545 BC Ezekiel mentions the Greek city of Miletus in his books but does not mention visiting the place nevertheless there is no reason to assume Thales s experiments into static charges were the first or unique at the time    The Works of William Shakespeare William Shakespeare,1878    The Secret Doctrine Helena Petrovna Blavatsky,1893    The Secret Doctrine: Anthropogenesis Helena Petrovna Blavatsky,1902    Law Notes Albert Gibson,Robert McLean,1917    **The Stranger's Guide and Historical & Biographical Hand-book to Oxford, from the Earliest Ages to the Present Time** ,1899    **The Law Times Reports** ,1905
