

Urban Landscape Survey in Italy and the Mediterranean builds upon all these new developments and is one of the first publications to focus exclusively upon the contribution of survey techniques to our understanding of ancient towns. It addresses methodology led inquiry into the nature of urban settlements primarily in Italy but also in Greece, Turkey, Croatia, Portugal and Spain.
